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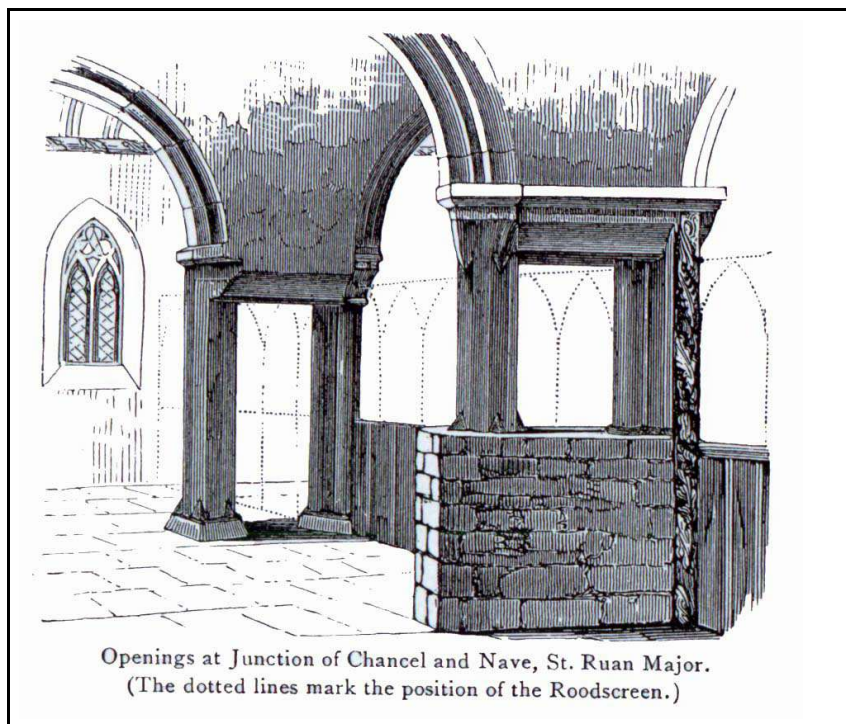
The Parish of Ruan Major - Background

Located on the Lizard Peninsular, the parish of Ruan Major is a very rural parish of 2485 acres but with a small population - only 163 people in 1841. The church is now a ruin and this parish, together with the parishes of Ruan Minor and Grade are united as Grade-Ruan. The abandoned church is located at Ordnance Grid Ref. SW7016 and is located at the end of a narrow road, the church is not sign posted, parking is limited and appears to be discouraged, it is almost as if there is a desire for this atmospheric ruin and its churchyard to be forgotten about.

The ancient parish church was dedicated to St Rumon or Ruan (the churches of Ruan Minor and Ruan Lanihorne were also dedicated to this Irish saint). It originally comprised a chancel, nave, and north and south aisles; the rood stairs in the north wall, a south porch, a priest's door and a north door. But it became considerably dilapidated and was pulled down in 1866. Fortunately, Blight gave an illustrated account of the original in his book *Churches of West Cornwall* (1865) pp.90 - 95.

Polsue (1867) described the new church as "rebuilt with chancel and nave only; the arcades, which had each five four centred arches, were with their pillars built into the walls." The original tower remains, it is 45 feet in height, has two stages, and is finished with battlements and crocketed pinnacles, having floriated finals. The structure is composed of alternate blocks of granite and serpentine stone, which give it a chequered appearance." Polsue also stated that this small parish has "neither dissenting place of worship, school, village or inn." However, a small Methodist chapel was subsequently erected near Mount Herman but this is now a private house. The rebuilt church ceased to be used for worship in the 1940's and the church is now a roofless ruin gradually deteriorating and yet well worth a visit.

The survey (carried out in June, 2003) found a few surviving church plaques placed on the ground in the belfry area and exposed and deteriorating (sadly, on a revisit in 2004 it was noted that memorial Ref. 2 was no longer in the church - stolen?). There were fifty three headstones in the churchyard with 114 names. At the time of the survey the churchyard was badly overgrown (as were the public paths and bridle way near the church) although it is understood that Kerrier District Council do cut the vegetation from time to time. Some of the headstones survive from the period before the church was rebuilt in 1866, the earliest death recorded is 1782, the latest date is 1986. There is one official war grave (CWGC).



J.T. Blight published a detailed description of the Parish Church of Ruan Major in 1865. That church was demolished in the late 1860s and a replaced with a smaller church which now lies in ruins. The original Thirteenth century tower survives.

The Former Parish Church of St Ruan - Memorials

- 1 Written in the book of life. To the glory of God in memory of ALEXANDER PENGILLY, of "Trevis" in this parish, born Nov. 17th 1853, died April 20th 1910. Resting in the hope of a glorious resurrection. Erected by his youngest son ALEXANDER JAMES PENGILLY.
Attached to wall in tower. Marble plaque, inset letters, fixed to slate base.
- 2 Sacred to the memory of ALEXANDER PENGILLY born Febry. 2nd 1815, died Febry. 23rd 1910. RIP. Marble plaque, lying loose in tower (at June, 2003). When the site was revisited by CIP in Sept.2005 this plaque was missing.
Pieces of a missing wall plaque, two marble borders and slate base. Lying loose in tower.
- 3 Granite tombstone cover, shaped in the tapering Saxon fashion. No inscription visible. Polsue refers to "an ancient priest's tomb, on which is sculptured a Calvary cross in relief, is preserved".
- 4 East Window. Some vandalism. No dedication. Hals (1737) noted that a previous window was "lately extant" in the church which depicted the arms of the ERISEY family. Described as "in a field sable a chevron between three griffins segreant" they had been granted to James Erissey, Sheriff of Cornwall, 4 Henry VIII. This window was probably replaced in the 1860's with the present one.
- 5 Bell. One bell only was mentioned by Polsue (1867), there is now no bell in the tower, if it had an inscription it is not known.
- 7 Wall plaque, only traces left on belfry wall.

- 10 Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord. Rev. Chap. 14. Ver. 13. Sacred to the memory of JAMES LUGG and JANE LUGG his granddaughter. He died 31 Oct. 1818 aged 77 years. She died 24th Aug. 1818, aged 3 years.
Sinners awake lest vengeance sleep no more,
Forsake your sins and pray to be forgiven.
Slate upright, etched, some damage, leaning against east wall of church.
- 11 In loving memory of WILLIAM LUGG who died Jany. 13th 1879, aged 73 years. Also ofANDAL// BETSY His wife who died Decr. 19th 1864, aged 57 years. And of their infant children ELIZA aged 2 years. RASMUS PASCOE aged 1 year. Thy will be done.
Stone upright with inset lettering lying prone face up broken into several pieces.
- 12 Sacred to the memory of JAMES LUGG, who died 19th August 1845, aged 74 years. Also of SARAH, his wife, who died 24th November 1851, aged 73 years. The memory of the just is blessed.
Slate upright, etched, monumental mason : Oliver & Sons, Falmouth.
- 13 O death where is thy sting ?
Sacred to the memory of MARY the wife of JOHN TONQUE of the parish of Grade.
Nature had distinguished her by great gentleness of disposition;
But convinced in early life of her fallen estate,
She eventually sought and obtained the forgiveness of her sins,
Through faith in the atonement of Christ,
The fruit of her conversion was life of unaffected piety,
In which she proved a wife and mother from the Lord.
She sweetly fell asleep in Jesus, Oct. 7th, 1836, in the 60th year of her age.
Slate upright, neat etching, at the bottom small inscription which appears to read : lugg scubisit era mpo und. A good example of a slate headstone.
- 14 Substantial granite kerbs, no inscription found, but very overgrown at time of survey.
- 15 Sacred to the memory of HENRY ANGOVE who departed this life on the 17th day of October 1848, in the 51st year of his age. "To die is gain." Also of LOVDY, his wife, who departed this life on the 10th day of Augst. 1849, in the 52nd year of her age. ! Whilst I say unto you, I say unto all watch."
Slate upright, etched using a variety of script, monumental mason : H. Skewes, Sc.

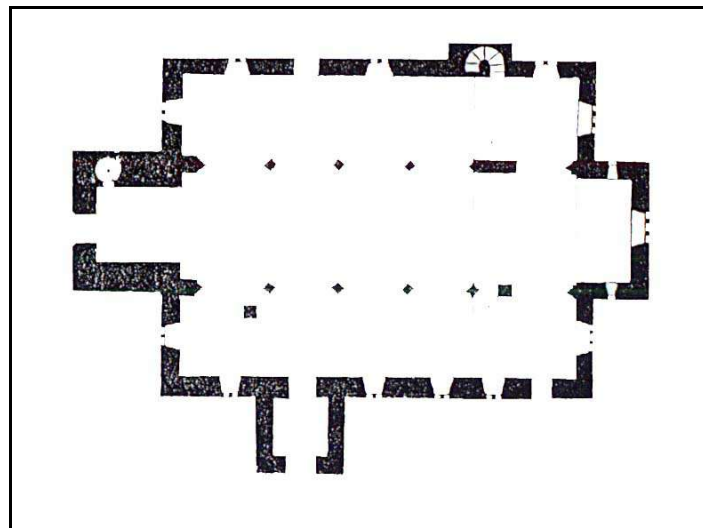
- 16 In memory of JACOB son of JOHN and SUSANAH COAD who died March 19th 1861, aged 36 years. Also SUSANAH their grandchild who died September 26th 1858, aged 7 years. "Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord."
Slate, etched, Maltese cross etched, monumental mason : R. Paul, Helston.
- 17 In loving memory of HARRY HARDWICK beloved husband of LAURA, who fell asleep 25th March 1966, aged 75 years. Also wife of the above LAURA, who died 5th April 1979, aged 87 years.
Low composite upright with kerbs, inset letters.
- 18 IHS. In affectionate remembrance of JOHN COAD, who died May 7th 1878, aged 94 years. So he died, being old and full of days, whose end was peace.
Slate upright, etched.
- 19 In loving memory of THOMAS STEVENS who died at Ruan Minor, October 18th 1893, aged 83 years. Also THOMAS STEVENS and BETSY STEVENS father and mother of the above. Asleep in Jesus. Also of MARY EXELBY, daughter of the last named. THOMAS & BETSY STEVENS, who died Jan. 12th 1903, aged 83 years. Thy will be done.
Marble upright, etched includes rose emblem.
- 20 In loving memory of ELIZABETH COAD died at Ruan Minor Feb. 28, 1933, aged 86. Peace perfect peace.
Marble upright, inset letters.
- 21 In loving memory of WILLIAM BOSUSTOW who died April 9th 1813, aged 39? Years. JAMES who died Novr. 22nd 1828? Aged 22 years. If not on earth in heaven we may meet again.
Sandstone upright, etched, very worn with Maltese cross.
- 22 In memory of MICHAEL HOCKING who departed this life January 25th 1876, aged 68 years. Nine lines of worn epitaph.
Slate, etched worn lettering. Monument mason : R. Paul Helst.
- 23 In affectionate remembrance of SUSSANA the beloved wife of MICHAEL HOSKING who died December 5th 1889, aged 75 years. God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death. Also of MARY ANN and MICHAEL HOSKING, children of the above who died in infancy. Also WILLIAM JOHN and CHARLES HOSKING grandchildren of the above who died in infancy. Safe in the arms of Jesus.
Slate upright, etched lettering.
- 24 In loving memory of MARY beloved daughter of M & S HOSKING, who died at Tredinnick, St Keverne, April 30th 1922, aged 73 years. Sunset and evening star, and one clear call for me.
Granite upright, inset letters, kerbs.
- 25 In memory of JOHN & JANE HOSKING, both died 1909. RIP.
Marble plaque, inset lettering, lying against headstone no. 24.
- 26 In loving memory of JOHN HOSKING who died at Crowan July 11th 1909, aged 71 years. Also of JANE, his wife, who died Jany 7th 1909, aged 70 years.
They are gone but not forgotten,
Never shall their memories fade,
Sweetest thoughts shall ever
Linger round the spot where
They are laid.
Marble upright, inset letters, kerbs.
- 27 In loving memory of WILLIAM the devoted husband of LYDIA MARY HOSKING who died at Church Town, Ruan Major, April 10th 1936, aged 64 years. Peace perfect peace.
Granite upright, inset letters, kerbs.
- 28 In loving memory of WILLIAM CURNOW, who died at Carless, Ruan Minor, April 26th, 1898, aged 60 years.
Come unto me all that labour and are heavy laden and I will give you rest.
Also of MARY ANN, his wife, who died Oct. 29th 1902, aged 60 years.
We are gathering homeward one by one.
Marble upright, inset letters with a leaf pattern in inserted lead. Monumental mason : Parry, Meneage St., Helston.
- 29 *Granite kerbs, with flower pots. No inscription found, but very overgrown and needs clearing for full check.*
- 30 In loving memory of CLARA BASHER died Nov. 29 1944, aged 78. Also of R. H. BASHER, died 12th September, 1939, aged 72.
Open book, shaped granite upright, with inset letters.

- 31 In loving memory of my darling sister GERALDINE ETHEL CURNOW passed away March 1986, aged 90 years.
Concrete upright, inset letters, kerbs.
- 32 To the memory of JULIA ANN CURNOW, (nee BOSUSTOW) 1871 - 1955. Also of her son WILLIAM GEORGE, 1894 - 1916. At rest.
Granite upright, inset letters.
- 33 *Low very worn granite upright, moss covered, transcript not made out.*
- 34 In loving memory of CHARLES STONE who died June 12th 1942, aged 88 years. Also of EMILY, his wife, who died Nov. 14th 1903, aged 40 years. Resting in the Lord.
Granite upright, inset letters. Kerbs.
- 35 In loving memory of GRACE, beloved wife of WILLIAM SMITH, who died at Nirvan, April 1st 1908, aged 68 years.
- His languished head is at rest,
Its troubles and thinking are o'er,
This quiet immovable breast
Is heaved by affliction no more,
This heart is no longer the seat
Of trouble and torturing pain,
It ceases to flutter and beat,
It never shall flutter again.
- Also of the aforesaid WILLIAM SMITH, who died May 30th 1915, aged 74.

Marble plaque inset letters, leaning in front of 35.

Official War grave (CWGC), sandstone.
- 38 In loving memory of MILLICENT beloved daughter of R. H. & C. BASHER, who died at Kugoor Grade, Sept. 18, 1903, aged 9 years.
Marble Latin cross on two tiers, child size, inset letters.
- 39 In loving memory of OLIVE IVEY STONE who died 8th June 1947, aged 50 years. Also her husband CHRISTOPHER CHARLES who died 23rd Dec. 1974, aged 88 years.
Granite kerbs, marble plaque at east end with inset letters.
- 40 In loving memory of REGINALD LLEWELLYN LUGG, who died 15th Dec. 1949, aged 49 years.
Granite upright, inset letters, kerbs.
- 41 FRANCIS BOSUSTOW, 1849 - 1922
SAMPSON BOSUSTOW 1848 - 1933.
ALICIA BOSUSTOW 1877 - 1962.
At rest.
- Polished granite upright, inset letters.*
- 42 In loving memory of JAMES, beloved husband of EDITH BENNETTS, who died at Hendra, Ruan Major, Dec. 10th 1916, aged 39 years.

- Polished granite upright, inset letters.*

- 44 In memory of JOHN LAITY died May 17th 1910, aged 71 years. Prepare to meet thy God.
Slate upright, etched.
- 45 In loving memory of MARY beloved wife of THOMAS BOSUSTOW who died at Trelease Aug. 16th 1927, aged 80 years. At rest. Also of the above THOMAS BOSUSTOW, who died Feb. 26th 1936, aged 92 years. Peace, perfect peace.
Stone upright, inset letters, kerbs.

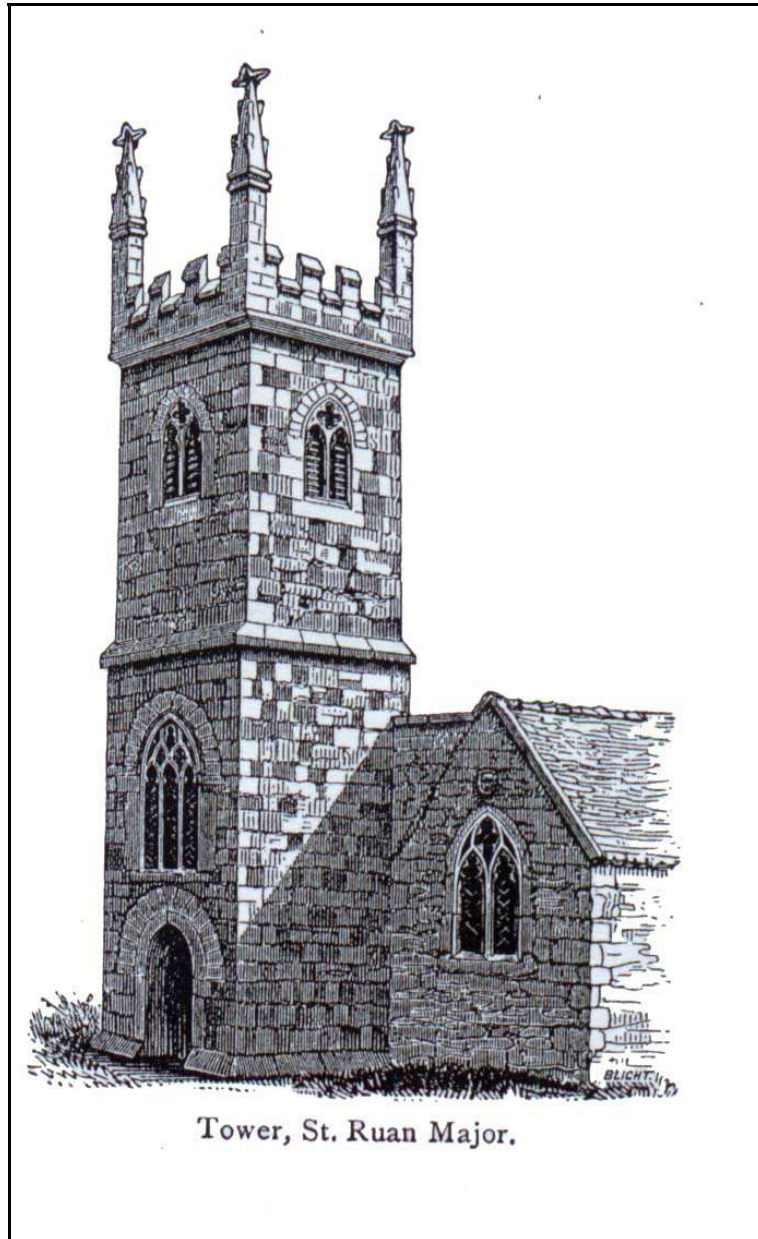

- 49 In memory of PRUDENCE, wife of JAMES LAMBRICK, who departed this life 25th Jan. 1842, in the 35th year of her age. In full assurance through the merits of her redeemer of a resurrection to life eternal.

Stone upright, small, etched lettering, leaning against 56 which it partly obscures.
 Also of JOHN GEORGE their son who died July 24th 1792, aged 24 years. Prepare to follow.
Small slate upright, etched, about fifteen feet away from 57. Small measuring about 2 ft by 3½ ft.
- 58 In loving memory of ELIZABETH HILDA PENGILLY, died 8th November 1970, in her 83rd year.
 Also of Alexander JAMES PENGILLY died 3rd September, 1972, in her 83rd year.
Polished granite kerbs, inset letters.
- 59 ALEXANDER PENGILLY, Trerise House, born Feby. 2nd 1856, died Feby. 23rd 1910.

- 64 In memory of MARY JANE beloved wife of RICHARD BOSUSTOW who died at Mount Herman, The Lizard, July 1st, 1934, aged 82 years. Until the day break, and the shadows flee away. Also of the above RICHARD BOSUSTOW who died at Mount Herman Dec. 26th, 1942, aged 87 years. Reunited.

When the Parish Church of St Ruan was rebuilt in the 1860s the north and south aisles were demolished and much of the stonework cannibalised. The above is a sketch plan of the church as found by J. T. Blight in 1865, before the rebuild.



Sketch by J. T. Blight (1865). The tower was not demolished when the church was rebuilt in the 1860's but the south aisle shown here was demolished.

The alternate blocks of serpentine and granite can clearly be seen in this sketch.

INDEX

If a person has more than one surname then there will be two entries in the index. Occasionally this will be because an alias is mentioned, more often there may be a married name and a maiden (given) name. This will aid the researcher who is only aware of one of the names.

If a person appears on more than one memorial there will be a separate entry (and reference number) for each, this means that an individual may appear in the index several times.

If there is no name (for instance "A Sailor" on an official war grave) the entry will be in lower case letters. If there is no personal name but the monument has been included in the register as being of interest then it's type will be entered in the surname field but in lower case letters e.g. Ancient Burial Chamber or Church Bell.

Nicknames or familiar names appear in brackets. In some cases the age has been computed from dates/years and therefore may not be accurate. If aged under 1 year then this appears as 0.
